Footnotes

DACITA (CHI) broke last but one, raced in the two path on the first turn, was unhurried at the back, came under urging while inside early on the far turn, angled three wide approaching the quarter-pole, swung six wide into the stretch then came under a right-handed whip, rallied on the outside, closed well to make a bid late, bumped with RAINHA DE BATERIA and narrowly prevailed under strong urging. RECEPTA came away in good order, went two then three wide on the first turn, settled comfortably in the middle of the field, was asked while two then three wide on the far turn, rallied four wide into the stretch, closed well to get the lead inside the furlong marker, led into the final sixteenth, drifted out under a left-handed whip late, brushed with RAINHA DA BATERIA and was denied. RAINHA DA BATERIA went two to three wide on the first turn, was reserved in the back half of the field, raced two then three wide on the far turn, swung five wide while roused into the stretch, rallied under the whip, closed well to make a bid between horses late, bumped with DACITA while also brushing with RECEPTA and just missed in a four-way photo. MISS TEMPLE CITY came away well, gave up positioning along the rail early, raced in the two path on the first turn, was rated towards the front, drafted in the two path on the far turn, waited behind horses from the quarter-pole to inside the three-sixteenths, found room then was asked in the vicinity of the furlong marker and finished with good courage but missed the trifecta. STRIKE CHARMER raced inside on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, saved ground while put to urging on the far turn, came off the rail late on that bend, shifted three wide into the stretch, moved out under a drive and finished willingly. ONUS raced in the two path on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, made a bid at the seven-sixteenths, vied in the two path on the far turn, took the lead near the quarter-pole, came under a left-handed whip in upper stretch, switched to a right-handed whip while in front into the final furlong, lost the advantage to RECEPTA shortly thereafter and weakened. MRS MCDUGAL went three wide on the first turn, was rated just off the pace on the outside, inched closer while three wide on the far turn, made a bid while given her cue at the quarter-pole, came under a drive in upper stretch, battled into the final furlong then tired. ISABELLA SINGS went to the front, set the pace near the inside while in hand, was let out on the far turn then asked at the quarter-pole, lost the advantage then dropped back in upper stretch and gave way. SANDIVA (IRE) was asked to move up inside of MISS TEMPLE CITY on the initial straightaway, rested that position from the aforementioned foe, was well placed on the inside, saved ground on the far turn, was asked outside the quarter-pole and came up empty. WEKEELA (FR) was last away,

raced inside on the first turn, settled near the back, was urged along leaving the backstretch, raced in the two path early on the far turn, moved to the four path approaching the quarter-pole and failed to respond. Following the race, the rider of RAIHNA DA BATERIA claimed foul against RECEPTA for alleged interference in deep stretch. After the stewards review, there was no change made to the order of finish. (Rail at 12 Feet)
